We look forward to working with you during your training and assessment at TasTAFE and/or onsite.

The way you undertake the training and assessment for your qualification generally will be off the job (at a TasTAFE campus) but it can also be a combination of off the job and in the workplace.

How your training and assessment is completed will be negotiated with your employer, your TasTAFE trainer and yourself. Your training will include both practical and theory-based work.

Training and assessment undertaken off the job at TasTAFE will be based around realistic simulated tasks, conducted in a simulated work environment, and any training and assessment undertaken on the job will utilise your daily work tasks.

TRAVEL / ACCOMMODATION ALLOWANCE

If you are entitled, accommodation and/or travel allowance are paid by the Tasmanian Government at the end of each off-the-job training period.

Please bring your bank account number and BSB details with you to your first TasTAFE training date to complete a travel form on your first day.

CAMPUS REGULATIONS

MANDATORY STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY

Work Health and Safety requires you to provide the following protective equipment:

- Wearing of cotton combination overalls when working in workshops is compulsory.
- Safety footwear (steel-capped). Any other footwear is unacceptable.
- Safety glasses Sunglasses are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Clear-lens to be worn in workshop areas at all times.
- Welding apprentices are also required to provide welding gloves and a welding helmet.

Failure to comply will result in being refused admission to practical areas until the appropriate equipment or clothing has been obtained.

WORKPLACE EVIDENCE

To make sure that you are getting the experience in the workplace you need to complete your qualification, you will need to collect evidence of what tasks/jobs you have been doing at work.

MyProfiling is an electronic method (App or www.my.edu.au) which you can use to gather evidence. It is a simple process that can be completed daily on your smart phone or on a computer.

You must have an email address and supply details on your enrolment to receive access to My Profiling.

You will be provided with login details once you enrol. If you are unable to use MyProfiling you can use workplace testimonials.

FEES, PAYMENT AND REFUNDS

Apprentices and Trainees are responsible for organising fee payment.

IF YOUR EMPLOYER IS PAYING YOUR FEES:

If your employer is paying your fees, your employer MUST complete and sign a Sponsor Authorisation Form which can be obtained from administration staff and presented at time of enrolment being processed.

IF YOU ARE PAYING YOUR FEES:

You or your employer will receive an invoice for your fees. These fees will be divided over the duration of your apprenticeship. If you are unable to pay the total amount, you may take advantage of our instalment plan. This can be negotiated with Client Services.

If fees remain outstanding results will be withheld until the amount owing is paid in full. No Certificates can be issued if you have outstanding fees.
