STRUCTURE:

HLTHPS006 - Online learning, activites and assessment via CANVAS

- 4 weeks to complete the online learning and assessments once enrolled
- I Day workshop at Clarence Campus for practical assessment

HLTAAP001 - Online learning and written assessment via CANVAS

- 4 weeks to complete the online learning and assessments once enrolled
- I day workshop at Clarence Campus for practical assessment for HLTHPS006.

*To be eligible for the Medication Skillset subsidy, you have to be an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident.

*Students can enrol in this skillset if they have already completed HLTAAP001 or HLTHPS006 as it can be credit transferred. They will need to provide evidence of their attainment of this unit so we can complete our credit transfer paperwork Plus supply a workplace testimonial of current competence.

* If the student holds an older unit for Healthy Bodies such as HLTAP301C or B then a gap assessment can be arranged.

MEDICATION REFRESHER (non-accredited) WORKSHOP \$92

HLTHPS006 Assist clients with medication

STRUCTURE:

I day workshop with in class activities as evidence of continued competence on campus at TasTAFE's Clarence Campus.

- Completed previous certificate HLTHPS006
- To enrol in the refresher course students will need to provide evidence of previous achievement of HLTHPS006 (best practice is to refresh knowledge and skills every three years).

Assessment process – important information

HLTAAP001 - Recognise Healthy Body Systems (online learning, activities and assessment).

HLTHPS006 – Assist clients with medication (online learning, activities and assessment and simulated practical assessment on campus during the booked workshop).

Students have three opportunities to complete assessments to the required standard.

If after three opportunities students are unable to be assessed as competent they will need to repeat the course, enrol again and pay the cost.

The time frames are two weeks for the medication course or healthy bodies alone or 4 weeks for the skill set. Extensions can be requested although when enrolling through a sponsor there may be a may workplace requirement that you complete withing the timeframe sponsored. You will need to let your manager know if there is any issues surrounding this.

If you arrive for a workshop and the online learning activities and assessments are not complete you will be asked to leave and do the work required and rebook another workshop.

Occasionally students repeatedly fail to attend for workshops that they have booked and do not notify the assessor. When this occurs the missed assessment will count as one assessment submission.

Booking process

If you would like to pay for the course, please fill out the attached Sponsorship form and have the attached Student Application Form Step 1: Personal Details and Course Selection Form filled out by the student, ensuring that the student's details are correct, written clearly and include their unique student indentifier (USI).

If the student does not have a USI please direct them to **www.usi.gov.au** and apply for one before returning the form.

Once enrolled the student will receive an email with the CANVAS student guide attached. This must be read carefully for log in and commencement of course details.

Once a student has been deemed competent, the Certificate/s shall be scanned through to you and the original shall be posted direct to the student.

If a student does not attend for a workshop and the booking was not cancelled 72 hours prior to start date of workshop the full course fee will apply. This also applies if the student has completed paperwork and enrolled but does not complete the online learning and assessment process within the allocated time frame and does not request extention of time.
