What is a Unique Student Identifier (USI)?

Everyone who undertakes vocational education and training in Australia must hold a USI. It is a unique number – just for you – which allows you to obtain a complete record of your training achievements from a single online source.

It means you cannot lose a qualification and makes it easier to keep track of your education and training history (which is great for when you need to apply for a job!). If you don't have a USI, you won't be able to receive recognition for your training – which would be a real shame.

OK, so I need a USI. What do I do?

Visit www.usi.gov.au and follow the prompts. You will need at least one or two forms of ID from the list below:

- Driver's Licence
- Medicare Card
- Australian Passport
- Australian Birth Certificate
- Citizenship Certificate
- Visa (with Non-Australian Passport)
- Certificate of Registration by Descent
- ImmiCard

When you create your USI please ensure you use your name exactly as it appears on your form of ID or you might get stuck.
